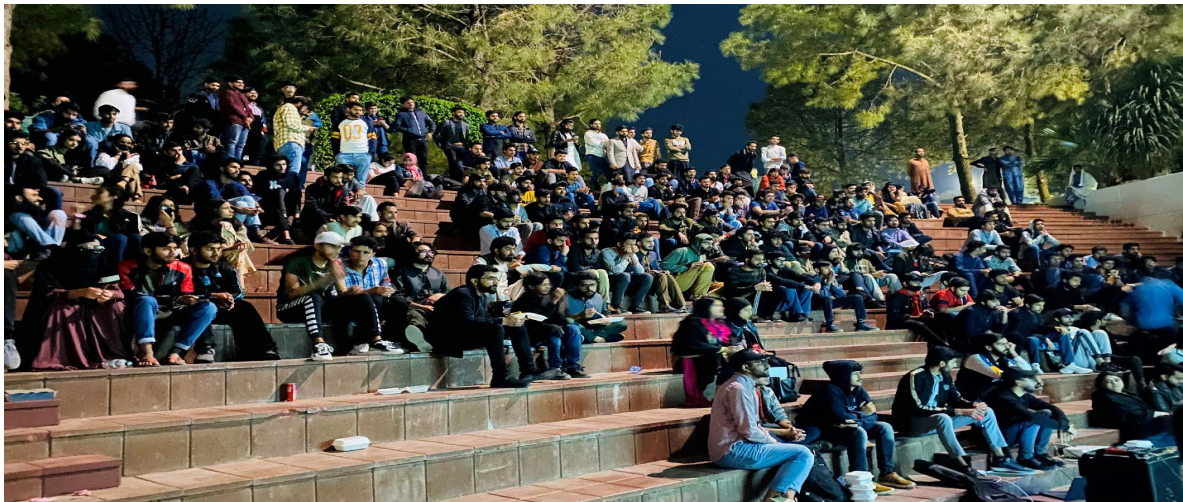
Love and Life

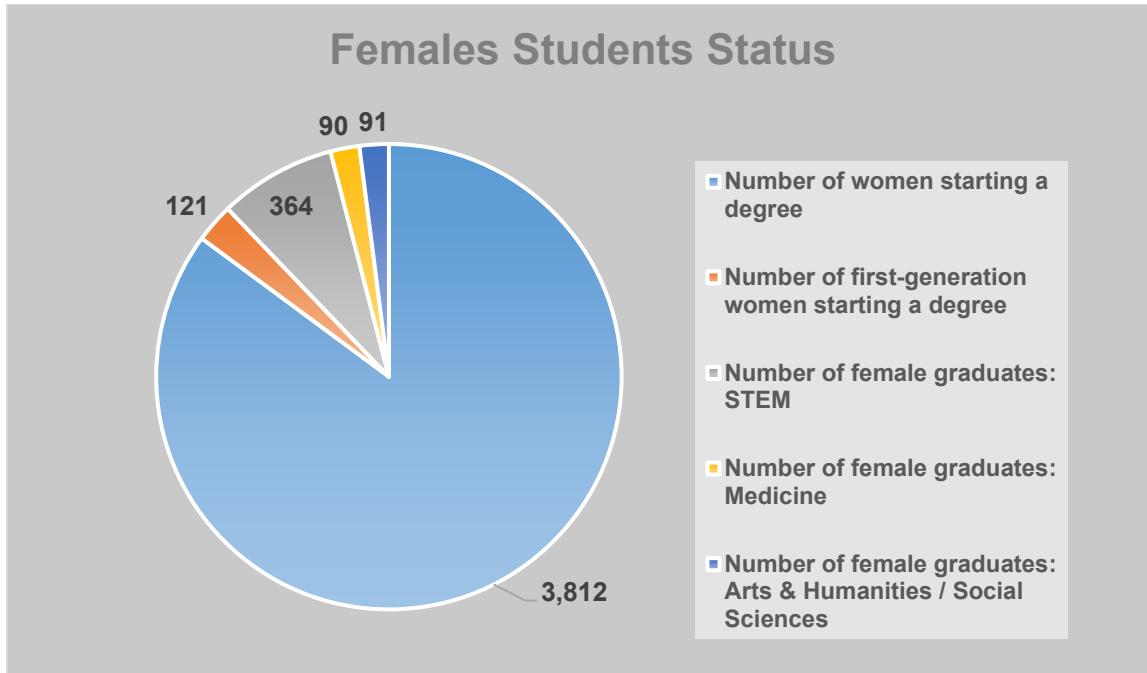

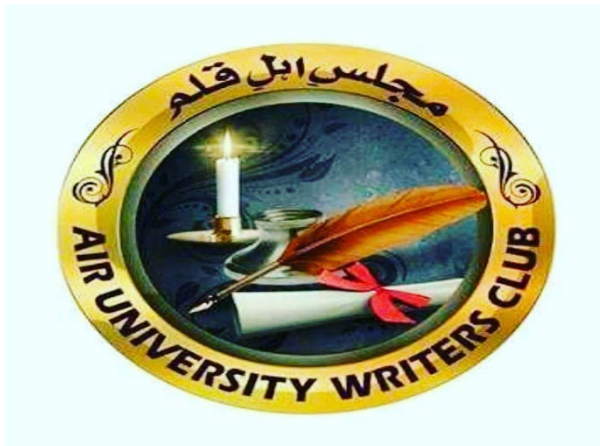
